FAIR project

The European project FAIR combines 10 partners, from 9 European countries, coordinated by Fondazione Nuovo Villaggio del Fanciullo (IT) and funded by the European Union's Justice Programme.

FAIR has addressed the problem of violent radicalisation with a special focus on the prison system. It attempts to elaborate an alternative model to traditional detention, one that includes disengagement and rehabilitation programmes for violent extremist offenders.

During its two years of implementation FAIR addressed and actively included the following target groups through several activities: 170 PROFESSIONALS WORKING IN THE PRISON AND PROBATION SYSTEM (penitentiary police, social workers, healthcare operators, volunteers, religious figures, lawyers and practitioners from civil society organizations) were involved in training courses to prevent/counter violent extremism; 50 INMATES, either openly radicalised or vulnerable to extremist recruitment, were involved in our rehabilitation program; 162 STAKEHOLDERS, including policy makers and representatives from penitentiary and judiciary institutions, were involved in a Feasibility study for a model of alternative to detention centres targeted at the rehabilitation of radicalised inmates.

In this final conference in Rome, the main results of project will be presented to the main stakeholders to discuss current challenges and future plans.
